National Expo

The Agrovision Expo 2025 showcased one of the most diverse agri-ecosystems in the country, with 500+ exhibitors covering agri machineries, Precision farming, irrigation, AI, seeds, horticulture, agri-inputs, livestock solutions, food processing, drones, renewable-energy tools, and MSME innovations.
