Central India's Largest Agri Summit

The 15th edition of Agrovision – Central India's largest agri summit – was successfully held at Nagpur from 22 to 25 November 2024. Continuing its tradition to be Central India's premier agriculture summit, this edition too received overwhelming response with over two fifty lakh footfalls from Vidarbha and its adjoining areas from Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh. It was inaugurated by Dr. Mohan Yadav, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Madhya Pradesh. National Expo

A huge national expo of agriculture activities related inputs, equipment, product display, along with financial, insurance and other services required by farmers was the integral and most important part of Agrovision 2024. It received overwhelming response as lakhs of farmers from Maharashtra and neighboring states visited the expo.

Big three hangers with total space of 10300 sq meters and open to sky space of 6000 sq meters, housed over 425 big and small companies displaying their products and services. It was an incredible exposure to visiting farmers of products, services, technologies, irrigation systems, equipment, tractors etc. A special section of start-ups was a special attraction for farmers as the start-ups displayed their grassroot level research, innovative products and services. 4 workshop halls of 1575 sqmt Besides private companies, some of the government organisations like-DRDO, IFCO, TRIFIED, NSTFDC FSI, CWC, CENTRAL WEAR HOSUSING CORPORATION, NHAI, IOCL, ONGC, NDDB, ICAR- NBSSLUP, Mother Dairy, MOES, State governments like Madhya Pradesh, Goa, Karnataka, Arunachal Pradesh and Assam, Financial institutions like State Bank of India, Punjab National Bank, Canara Bank, SIDBI participated in the expo to exhibit their schemes for farmers. IIT Kharagpur, in association with NABARD, showcased its incubation center initiatives for agritech startups for the first time at 15th Agrovision. IIT Roorkee showcased a mini electric tractor in the exhibition. Stalls by women's self-help groups various ready to make, ready to eat products and various other food items like pickles, papads, millets, Organic Jaggery, chilly and turmeric powder etc.





Special Workshops

The most unique and attractive part of the Agrovision is workshops for farmers conducted by subject experts. In 4 workshop halls of 1575 sqmt in all 41 workshops were organised and they were addressed by 100 experts. Some of the topics covered in the workshops included use of Drone in agriculture, increasing oil seeds production in vidarbha, Production of export quality banana, bamboo cultivation, cultivation of Dragon fruit, Mango cultivation in vidarbha farm mechanization Millets production and value addition and many more. Special workshops were organised on Opportunities in Food processing industry in Vidarbharegion, Farmers Producers Organisations (FPOs), Opportunities in Dairy Business in Vidarbha, Opportunities for Fisheries in Vidarbha, Technology for increasing production of orange and Use of Information Technology (IT) in . A special session was organized on Opportunities for youth in agriculture. Experts from academics and agri entrepreneur described what opportunities are available for youth if they choose agriculture as career in academics, research and industry. Large number of youths from agriculture universities, agri MBA institutes participated in the session.
